English genealogical research services are offered by the Centre for English Genealogy, P. O. Box 11631, Salt Lake City, Utah 84147 (Phone: 801-355-1662). They use the Genealogical Library in Salt Lake City, a London genealogist and record researchers in the English county towns. They also have compiled summaries of major genealogical records in English counties and lists of over half of the English parishes which are available at very nominal cost. The research services vary from \$20 to \$100. Their brochures have much more detail.

Researchers tracing Dutch ancestry will find the following article of considerable interest: "The Mandeville Genealogy" in the Fall-Winter 1979 issue of De Halve Maen, a quarterly publication of the Holland Society of New York. It goes back to the 1580's (400 hundreds ago). Some of the Mandeville descendants emigrated to New Amsterdam (N.Y.) and Bergen County (N.J.)
