BY - Law Changes The proposed by-law changes presented by the By-laws Committee plus recommended changes at the September 22 meeting were adopted by the membership at the October 27 meeting. Some of the key changes are: Officers shall be elected for a term of two years. An officer cannot serve two consecutive terms in the same office. There will be both a Recording Secretary and a Corresponding Secretary. The Executive Board shall consist of the president, vice-president, treasurer, recording secretary, corresponding secretary and the most recent available past president.

IRISH RESEARCH (Notes compiled by Jane Verdicchio from Irish Gen. Workshop
Many people feel it is futile to undertake research on Irish ancestors due to the disasterous fire in Dublin in 1922. It is true that the National Archives was almost totally destroyed. However, there are still many sources available.

1. Church of Ireland records for Northern Ireland were in local custody and are now available through PRONI (Public Record Office Northern Ireland), Belfast.

2. Irish Civil Registration started in 1864, for Protestant marriages 1845. Copies from the local District Registrars for all of Ireland are now on deposit at Registrar General's Office, Custom House, Dublin.

- 3.Roman Catholic Registers for all of Ireland were never in the PRO (Public Record Office) therefore were not destroyed in 1922. These were microfilmed by the National Library in the 1960's. Those for Northern Ireland are available to be researched in PRONI, Belfast. For the Republic of Ireland, The records are available for review in Dublin, but ONLY with permission of the parish priest or Bishop. If a visit is planned, it is wise to write well in advance for clearance. Hopefully this situation will change in the future.
- 4.Regardless of your ancestors religion, it is always wise to check Church of Ireland registers. Many people found it necessary to register births and marriages there due to the Penal Laws. Frequently, the Church of Ireland graveyard was used for the whole community.
- 5.If you are writting to a local parish, the suggested donation is \$10.
- 6.Householder's Index available through LDS and N.Y.Public Library. This is a massive work compiled in 1960. It is a name index listing the occurrence of surnames in each County based on the Tithe Applotment Books(1823-37) and Griffith's second Valuation(1860). On microfiche.
- 7.Griffith's Valuations and the Tithe Applotment Books may then be used

to find the location of ancestors. Listed are occupiers of land, tenants, houses and is the nearest thing to a farm census.

8. Ulster Genealogical and Historical Guild, 66 Balmoral Ave, Belfast BT9 5NY, Northern Ireland. Formed to promote interest in Ulster Genealogy. Subscription rate £ 5 sterling, includes two newsletters per year, 10% discount on publications and research fees, plus annual list of research in progress with subscribers addresses.

9. Genealogical Research Tours to Ireland and Scotland are arranged and conducted by Mrs. Donna R. Hotaling, D.R.H. Associates, 2255 Cedar Lane, Vienna, Virginia. 22180.

10. Gravestone Inscriptions: 18 volumes have been completed for County Down and work is in progress on County Antrim with one volume completed so far. These and other books available through Ulster Genealogical and Historical Guild.

11. Personal research: I had success with the help of an Irish cousin who worked through the Local Registrar. Through them, I have obtained the birth record of my grandmother, 7 of her brothers and sisters and the death record of my great-grandmother.

ANCESTOR CROSS INDEX

We are now in the process of establishing a 3"x 5" card surname cross-index reference file. Those members of the society who are willing to answer inquiries are requested to submit the surnames for which they can supply genealogical information.

Each surname together with the general areas, i.e., county and state, state, or country, to which the genealogical information applies, should be printed or typed on an individual 3" x 5" index card. The surname should be shown on the left side of the top line, with the general area below. In addition, the name of the member submitting the card should be shown on the right and below the middle of each card. One additional "member" card should be submitted with the member's name and complete address in the upper left of this card. All cards should be turned in to Harvey Forrest, Chairman of the Ancestor Index Committee.

Those members whose area of residence makes it impossible to attend the Society's meetings, and who wish to participate in the surname cross-index file, may send a printed or typed list of the information requested above, to: Harvey Forrest, 103 Ash St., Westwood, N.J. 07675. The Ancestor Index Committee will then prepare the necessary index cards.

When the surname cross-index file is ready for use, persons who wish to contact a member for information regarding a surname should write to Harvey Forrest at the above address, giving the surname or surnames and enclosing a self-addressed, stamped envelope. The Society's fee for this service will be \$1.00 per surname. Checks should be drawn to the order of "Genealogical Society of Bergen County, N.J."

ANCESTOR CROSS INDEX (cont)

The inquirer will receive a photo-copy of the surname card and of a member card giving the name and address of the member who has genealogical information related to the particular surname. The inquirer should then write directly to the member listed on the member card, giving as much information as possible about the person whose lineage they are endeavoring to trace. That information should, if possible, include: full name, date of birth, place of birth, date of marriage, name of spouse, earliest know place of residence, etc. A self-addressed stamped envelope should be included with the inquiry.

There will be an announcement in the May 1982 issue of "The Archivist" when the Ancestor Cross Index will be ready for use.

FORT WAYNE (IND.) PUBLIC LIBRARY. Founded in 1961, the Fred J. Reynolds Historical and Genealogical Department of the Fort Wayne, Indiana Public Library is second only to the Mormon Library in Salt Lake City in the extent of it's holdings. The collection now contains 116,000 books, more than 6,000 periodicals and 30,734 rolls of microfilm. Among its many features are (1) the Baldwin collection of western Pennsylvania and eastern Ohio data, (2) a copy of the Draper collection of information about the old northwestern frontier, the region surrounding the Great Lakes, (3) a microfilmed set of North Carolina records by county and (4) abstracts of local documents for W. Virginia and Tennessee. (per Bill Amerman from Jan/Feb 1981 issue of Americana.)

BERGEN COUNTY, N.J. RESEARCH HINTS (By Maria Hopper)

Anyone trying to find their ancestors in Bergen County is fortunate to have three excellent genealogies to guide them in their search:

1. The Blauvelt Family Genealogy compiled by Louis L. Blauvelt, The Association Of Blauvelt Descendents, 1956.
2. The Demarest Family (two volumes), compiled by the Demarest Family Association (Voorhis Demarest, President), 1962. Plus the 1971 Supplement to the Demarest Family, 2nd edition. (Containing additions and corrections to the 1962 genealogies.)
3. The Zabriskie Family (two volumes) compiled by George Orlin Zabriskie, Publishers Press, Salt Lake City (utah), 1963.

These three genealogies are all extremely well researched and all feature families who for generations lived in the Dutch communities of Bergen Co., N.J., and Rockland Co., N.Y. You might easily overlook these books because to the best of your knowledge you have no Demarest, Blauvelt or Zabriskie in your family lines. However, you might still find it well worth your while to investigate these volumes.

They all have excellent indexes. The Demarest genealogy alone has a 241 page index with over 40,000 names. The Blauvelt and Zabriskie genealogies, unlike many genealogies, do not stop with the female lines but trace the descendants of females as well.

For example, I was able to find my husband's great grandfather, Thomas E. Brickell (#6209), the son of Maria Tallman (#2863) the daughter of Wyntje Haring(#1044) the daughter of Lidia Zabriskie (#353) in the Zabriskie genealogy. Unfortunately, I never thought to look in the Zabriskie genealogy until I had already traced the line back to Lidia Zabriskie, a process which took some six months. It

would have taken much less time had I checked the Zabriskie index first.

That is not to say that these genealogies do not contain errors. They, like all books of their kind, have many. But they are well documented and they could be a great help in searching for Bergen County (N.J.) roots.

MORE RESEARCH HINTS AND SUGGESTIONS

Muriel Wassmann, 27 Sullivan Drive, Emerson, N.J. 07630, has at her disposal some copies of Valentine's Manual from the years 1916 through 1921. In them are listed old marriage and death notices from New York City during the period 1789- 1799. They were compiled by A. J. Wohlhagen (or Wall) from the "New York Weekly Museum". She will be glad to make a search for an ancestor for \$2.00 per name. Please write to above address and enclose SASE.

Muriel also heartily recommends reading the recent book, Pioneer Women, by Joanna L. Stratton. If you have any ancestors who migrated or settled in Kansas this is an excellent book for learning how hard their task was in putting down roots. The book actually "wrote itself" as it was taken from the writings and reminiscences of 800 pioneer women who settled there between 1850 -1890. A list of the 800 women is included along with the sources, emigration year and age at that time. Muriel will search that too, for the SASE only.

BIBLE FOUND Muriel Henckler, one of the students in the 1981 genealogy class in Ridgewood, told a fascinating story about finding her great-grandparents' family Bible. In the course of her researching her family genealogy she called the Hunterdon County (N.J.) Historical Society to make an appointment to visit there in order to search their records. She mentioned she was interested in several names including Forrester. The librarian became very excited and explained that she had been in correspondence with a man in Hawaii about a family Bible which had been found in a pile of old books that were about to be sent to a dump. They were found by a schoolboy. The boy had brought the book to his school advisor who had shown it to her husband. How the 107 year old Bible of Andrew Forrester and Julia Best got to the island of Kailua in Hawaii from Hunterdon County is still a mystery. But Muriel was glad it was found. The Bible is now in the Hunterdon County Historical Society's Library. (per Maria Hopper - partially excerpted from Hunterdon County Democrat, 3/8/81)
