Instructions for preparing the cards or lists were given on page 5 of the November 1981 issue of the Archivist. All cards or lists should be turned in to Harvey Forrest, Chairman of the Ancestor Index Committee. They may also be mailed to Harvey Forrest, 103 Ash St., Westwood, N.J.07675

It is now anticipated that this new Ancestor Index file will not be ready for inquiries until June, at the earliest. When the Ancestor Index is ready for use, persons who wish to contact a member for information regarding a surname should write to Harvey Forrest at the above address, giving the surname or surnames, and a self-addressed, stamped envelope. The Society's fee for this service will be \$1.00 per surname. Checks should be drawn to the order of "Genealogical Society of Bergen County, N.J."

The inquirer will receive a photo-copy of the surname card and of a member card giving the name and address of the member who has genealogical information related to the particular surname. The inquirer should then

write directly to the member listed on the member card, giving as much information as possible about the particular person whose lineage they are endeavoring to trace. That information should, if possible, include: full name, date of birth, place of birth, date of marriage, name of spouse, earliest known place of residence, etc. A self-addressed, stamped envelope should be included with the inquiry. We would call to your attention that, in answering inquiries, our members can only be expected to supply information that they already have and that is directly related to the particular person mentioned in the inquiry. The member is not expected to perform research for the inquirer.

RESEARCH IN ENGLAND (By Annabelle Courtney)

This summer I was in London for a few days and would like to share my genealogy research experiences with you.

For the most part, research in London is quite simple and a very pleasant experience. The buildings where the records are kept are easily accessible to each other - right in the heart of the city of London.

They are clean, well lit and have adequate high desks to accommodate the researcher. Sections are clearly marked, and the name indexes are arranged neatly in quarterly ledgers on open shelves.

The employees are pleasant and helpful and you are free to search on your own. I felt like a child "let loose" in a toy shop! However, it can become very crowded, since many people do research not only for themselves but also for others.

Following are some of the buildings I visited and some facts about the records they contain.

General Register Office, St. Catherine's House, 10 Kingsway, London WC2B 6 JP England

Births and marriages recorded in all of England and Wales since July 1837 are available at St. Catherine's House. (Death records for same are located across the street in Alexandra House.) There is no charge for searching the indexes. A certificate is expensive; £4.60 (\$9.00) in person and £9.60 (\$18.00) by mail. Certificates provide the name(s) of individual(s), date of event, parents names and occupation, street address, county, parish and district. It is possible to obtain information even if you do not know the area but are sure of the name and date of event. Write and ask for application form and procedure information. Records before July 1837 are retained in county record offices. Information may possibly be obtained from them by mail. Addresses of these offices can be obtained by contacting Public Record Office (P.R.O.), Chancery Lane, London WC2A 1LR, England.

Census records for 1841, 1851, 1861, 1871, and 1881 are available at the Public Records Office. There is no name index so an exact address is needed to search for a census. These must be searched in person, but if you cannot go yourself, the P.R.O. will supply you with a list of professional researchers. This office also prints many useful leaflets, so if you contact them, ask them to send you a list of what is available.

SOMERSET HOUSE, The Strand, London WC2R 4L LB, England

Wills proved in England and Wales since 1858 are kept at the Somerset House. Indexes are on open shelves, in ledgers filed alphabetically

by name and year. Index tells name, date of probate, county and town where person lived, date of death, names of witnesses and executor. Charge to see the original is 25 pence. Will can be mimeographed by them for a fee.

My efforts in London were successful and I had the added bonus of visiting a beautiful, warm, and friendly city.

ANCESTOR SURNAME CROSS INDEX

A new Ancestor Surname Cross Index is now available for use at this Society's files in the Hillsdale Public Library, Hillsdale, N.J. From this index, one can obtain the name and address of a member of this Society who has genealogical information regarding a particular surname. The index and the Society's collections are available in the library's Reference Room, Monday through Wednesday from 1:00 P.M. to 9:00 P.M.; Thursday and Friday from 10:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.; and Saturday from 10:00 A.M. to 2:00 P.M.

Those persons who are unable to use the Index themselves, may write to the Ancestor Index Committee, c/o the Society's secretary. (Inquiries regarding the Index should not be sent to the Hillsdale Public Library) A committee member of the Society will advise the inquirer whether a particular surname is listed in the Index; and if it is, the name and address of the member of the Society who has genealogical information on the particular surname. For this service, a donation of \$1.00 for each surname and a self addressed, stamped envelope are requested. Checks should be drawn to the order of "Genealogical Society of Bergen County, N.J."

A photo-copy of the surname card and of the member address card will then be sent to the inquirer. When the photo-copy is received, the inquirer should write directly to the member listed on the member card, giving as much information as possible about the person whose lineage they are endeavoring to trace. That information should, if possible, include: full name, date of birth, place of birth, date of marriage, name of spouse, earliest known place of residence, etc.

The Index is composed of a set of over 1,300 3" x 5" index cards bearing ancestor surnames and a member name. It also includes a set of cards bearing the name and address of the member of the Genealogical Society who has genealogical information related to the particular surname.

GENEALOGY PARTICIPATION
