NORTHERN IRELAND GENEALOGY

The Ulster Genealogical and Historical Guild, part of the Ulster Historical Foundation, publishes an annual newsletter and other items on Ulster and Irish genealogy. Membership is \$12.00 a year. The address is: Ulster Historical Foundation, 66 Balmoral Ave., Belfast BT9 6NY, Northern Ireland.

A genealogical search service also is offered on a fee-paying basis. The average search and report costs about \$80.00, including a \$20.00 non refundable administrative charge. The search fee will not exceed \$120.00 without prior consultation. Currently, there is a waiting period of six months from registration until work can begin on a search.

The Ulster Historical Foundation also publishes a genealogical series of volumes recording graveyard inscriptions and has published several historical volumes, including "Ulster Emigration to Colonial America, 1718-1775". (Excerpted from The Scottish Merchant, October 1983)

The June 25 meeting (a 4th Monday) will consist of a visit to the Old Paramus Church and the Schoolhouse Museum both on Glen Avenue in Ridgewood just west of Route 17. RESEARCHING PUBLIC RECORDS FOR NEW YORK CITY ANCESTRY
(by Annabelle Courtney of Westwood, N.J.)

Research in the five boroughs (Manhattan, Brooklyn, Bronx, Queens, and Richmond) is possible although often slow and expensive. Listed below are the public record offices where information can be obtained. I've included addresses, approximate costs and record holdings in each. The first rule in all cases of vital records is to write and ask for the correct form. Always include an SASE.

1. Vital Records - 1910 to present in the 5 Boroughs. Separate form needed for each request. Can be searched in person for a fee. Write for current forms and charge. Dept. of Health, Vital Record Division, 25 Worth St., New York, N.Y. 10013. Ph: 212-247-0130.
2. Vital Records prior to 1910 in the 5 Boroughs. All holdings (most on microfilm) may be searched in person for 4 hours for \$5.00. If no one is waiting for a reader, you may continue past that time. They only accept payment by check - NO CASH. Records are incomplete so when you write for the forms, ask them to send a copy of their holdings.
They also have an 1890 special census record that was conducted in Manhattan only. This is not on film and you must know the Ward number that you want. Municipal Archives, 52 Chambers St., New York, N.Y. 10007. Ph: 212-566-5292.
3. Court Cases. Write for information as to availability and procedure to: Court Records, 709 Surrogate Court, 31 Chambers St., New York, N.Y. 10007. (Open to the public Tues. and Thurs. only.) No charge. Also has the 1855 New York City State Census and maps defining Ward numbers.

In any case, you must know the Ward number of the area that you want. Ward maps are available at these offices and you must look at them yourself. An exact street address is necessary.

Holds records of all applications for and citizenship papers granted in the N.Y. area. Send them what you want to know and they will bill you if they have the information you want.

NATIONAL ARCHIVES MILITARY RECORDS & PASSENGER ARRIVAL RECORDS.

As of May 1, 1984 all requests for military service records or passenger arrival records must be submitted on NATF Forms 80 and 81, respectively. Copies of these forms are available from Reference Services Branch (NNIR), National Archives and Records Service, 8th and Pennsylvania Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20408.

Do not send in payment with the forms. NAR will research the request, prepare copies of any records located, and hold the copies for 30 days or until payment is received, whichever is sooner.

NAR will bill the researcher.

A separate NATF Form 80 is desired for each file (pension or bounty-land or compiled military service).

SWEDISH RESEARCH SOURCES

The Emigrant Institute in Vaxjo, Sweden contains much material relating to Swedes emigrating to other countries, especially the U.S., and Canada. Its research room is equipped with microfilm readers. Materials include extensive register of passenger manifests (since 1869) and Lutheran parish records (since the late 17th century) like clerical surveys and out-migration records. It also has files on places and churches in the U.S. and Canada that Swedes went to or settled, e.g., microfilms of Swedish-American church archives. Provincial archives in the following Swedish cities also keep parish records prior to 1900: Lund, Göteborg, Vadstena, Visby, Uppsala, Östersund, Härnösand, Malmö and Stockholm.

The Institute's guide for family research services indicates that requests for help are limited to where the emigrants came from in Sweden, their destination, and their birth data. There is a basic fee of \$20. U.S. for each emigrant traced. More extensive research projects are referred to professional archivists (implies fees are negotiable). For more detail write to the Institute at Emigrant Institutet, Box 201, S-351 04, Vaxjo, Sweden.
