THE MEAD FAMILY OF NORTHERN NEW JERSEY

Joe Svenson, one of our past presidents and now residing in Cape Coral, Florida, donated a copy of a 167 page genealogy manuscript entitled The Mead Family of Northern N.J. to our Society's collection. It includes a 13 page surname index. The manuscript was edited by Margaret Angevine Riggin of Bloomfield, N.J., in 1979. It includes research data compiled by George Budd Mead of Montclair, N.J., Kathie Sheris Ritchey of Falls Church, Va., Sallie Lindsley Black of Glen Ridge, N.J., and Alfred A. and Beatrice Mead Hagedorn of Colorado Springs, Colo. All except Mr. Hagedorn are Mead descendants.

The genealogy of this "Dutch" Mead family covers six generations (thru the early 1900's in some cases), mostly in America. It starts with Peter Jansen Mead who came from Holland to New Amsterdam in 1663. Early generations of Mead descendants lived in what are now Bergen, Passaic, Morris and Essex counties of New Jersey. They include many old northern N.J. family names, both of Dutch and non-Dutch origin.

Both Joe Svenson and Kate Randall's husband Harry are direct descendants of this Mead family. It's likely that quite a few other members (or their spouses) of our Society also are Mead descendants.

THE BROWER FARM (TAPPAN, N.Y.) & REVOLUTIONARY WAR HISTORY

(Published by The Historical Society of Rockland Co., N.Y. in "South of The Mountain", Jan.-Mar. 1978. Copy of a letter received by Col. John B. Clark, Ret., from his grandfather Henry Baker sometime between 1928 and 1930. Col. Clark sent the letter to Dan deNoyelles who submitted it to "South of The Mountain".)

To Bud,

Here inunder is a bit of history some of which you will not find in your School books to Wit-Major Andre, Tappan, Rockland County, New York, and the Brower family having to do with this bit of history as you read in your book as follows: Major Andre and Benedict Arnold negotiated (sic) for a sum of money, (I think it was 10,000 pounds or \$50,000) to surrender West Point, New York. The agreement made, Signed Sealed and Delivered by Arnold to Andree, who in trying to make his way back to New York City, was Captured by Vanwart, Paulding, and Williams while going through Tarrytown. The letter read and found to contain the terms of surrender in West Point, Major Andre was taken to Tappan and lodged in prison there. This Prison house still stands in perfect condition.. Andre was tried and found guilty and sentenced to be hung. He paid this penalty by being hung by the neck on the Brower Farm, He was hung between two cedar trees, a pole being thrown across them.

Many years ago it was decided to place a Monument at Tarrytown on the spot of his capture, This was done and this Monument has been blown up twice since then. It has not been disturbed since it was repaired.

The cedar trees in Tappan stood for many Years. When they began to rot, my Great Grandfather Brower (thought to be David Brower, from research done by Col. John B. Clark) decided to cut them down, which he did. About twenty years before Grandpa Isaac D. Brower died (Aug 30, 1894) it was decided to erect a stone on the spot of the execution, David Brower, a Nephew of Grandpa Isaac D. Brower, was called upon to determine the exact spot of hanging.

The trees were gone and all landmarks swept away. David Brower found he could not select the spot. Several Old timers were called in with like results, David Brower turned to the committee and said there was one man who could select the spot, He said, "If Uncle Isaac Brower cannot do it then there is no one who can." Grandpa Brower was taken to Tappan, Upon arrival there he, too, thought he could walk up the hill and pick out the spot. He found out that it could not be done. Grandpa Brower then told the committee. "as a boy I played under these cedar trees and could stand in my Mothers Kitchen door at a certain hour of the day with the sun in the west and the sun was between those two cedar trees." Grandpa took the position in the doorway and an Engineer stood on the hill and Grandpa moved the Engineer around untill satisfied and the Monument was placed on the spot selected by your Great Grandfather Isaac D. Brower.
